The Environmental Excellence Awards program is co-sponsored by *Concrete Products* magazine. The program offers producers national recognition for outstanding contributions to protecting the environment and maintaining sound environmental management practices in their operation. The program salutes companies that have not only met, but surpassed governmental compliance requirements and demonstrated a commitment to environmental excellence through plant and staff investment. The program provides awards in five categories based on the plant's production volume. Eligible plants include NRMCA producer members located in the U.S., its territories, or Canada.
